Today, we in Kitchener at the home of Sean Kelley. Three years ago, Sean was in a catastrophic motorcycle accident. As he finds his way back to independence there are few things he has to do a little bit differently.

One of them is cooking and preparing his own food. To that end, Pro Accessibility's Pat Acquisto was brought in to work with the occupational therapist and redesign his kitchen. Today we're going to see that kitchen. Hi Pat.

I lived life on the edge. I loved going high speeds, motorcycle racing and whatnot. I got my pilot's license. I wanted to go up. All your loops. I wanted to tumble. Well, I was at Toronto Airport and I got my scuba license. I went to law.

Law?

Compound fractured leg, compound fractured arm, internal bleeding, bladder and spleen, rips of more than two inches on each one. Oh yeah.

You weren't supposed to make it.

No, no. I wasn't supposed to make it. Some people need a swift kick to the butt to fly right. Not me.

I needed to be taken to the end of life and saying you decide. I'm still fighting. Only thing I was supposed to be able to do is stare the window. Massive head injury. Can't do this. Can't do that. Hell with that.

No, I'm going to do it. I going to to teach myself.

But one of your tasks is learning how to prepare your own food and cook for yourself. Are you enjoying that?

Yes I am. I like putting together a list of things I need. Becomes a mental exercise for me, too. Buying healthy stuff and eat because I don't want

to get a wheelchair gut.

And in order to make that happen, this whole kitchen has been built just for you.

Yes it's very accessible because there's a difference between being in a wheelchair and pertaining to my injury.

Sean Kelley

Since my injury is a C-7 injury that means the muscles they have for midsection are very ... they're lacking very much.

Sean Kelley

So that's what makes it difficult for me when it comes to cooking. So it has to be done for a specific height and would be easier for me.

For those who have a C-7 injury, their nerves can control elbow extension and some finger extension. Most can straighten their arm and have normal movement of their shoulders. They can accomplish most activities of daily living by themselves, but may need assistance with more difficult tasks.

They may also be able to drive an adapted vehicle.

That's an interesting point, because I think a lot of people would think an accessible kitchen is an accessible kitchen, is an accessible kitchen. It's not. This is very much designed specifically for your needs.

For my injury, for my needs.

Well, I'm going to go and find out what Pat's doing and get him to give us a tour.

Tell me about the project, Pat.

Well, this design, we base it all on Sean's disabilities. Myself along with the OT,

we came up with what we think is the optimum fully accessible kitchen for Sean.

Occupational therapy as a health profession that empowers people of all ages to overcome barriers in their everyday lives so they can do more and live better through solutions created for each individual's unique needs.

Occupational therapists help people of all ages and abilities recover from an injury or illness, to participate in day to day activities and experience life to the fullest.

Although the kitchen overall size is not huge, there's a lot of hidden features that for the naked eye you may not realize but again, to Sean, it makes a huge impact day to day.

OK, let's start with the refrigerator.

So here we have the side-by-side fridge freezer. We have the filtered water and ice. The shelves are fully adjustable. He can



completely open the door sitting roll up right up against the fridge and access that.

Now we've talked about optimal reach zone on this show before, and that applies to this refrigerator and freezer as well because from Sean's seated position, he can have his most used items in the fridge and in the freezer within that optimal reach zone.

Makes it so much easier for him. Now we come along to the cupboards.

Yep, so one of the requests from Sean is he wanted to make sure he had access to all of his upper cabinets. So this one here in particular, because it was so close to the cooktop, we actually lowered it

so Sean can have access to the spices and all his preparation foods for his meals.

Terrific. Now this cooktop, I love these cooktops.

This cooktop is an induction cooktop and the way it functions and safety features is you need a magnetic pot or pan

then when it makes contact with the cooktop, it will start to cook. And the good thing about that, once you remove that pot, it always



this cool to touch so someone with a brain injury, you don't have that worry of them ever burning themselves.

And what I like about these as well is the controls are all at the front. So there's no reaching over hot pots, anything that's boiling. Love that. How high are these countertops, do you remember?

Your typical height, you always want to range between 35 and 36 inches, depending on the person that you're dealing with, their disability,

so this is probably in around 33 inches, I would say.

Mm hmm. And what was here before?

So there was full cabinets below, and if you can see how we designed we gave Sean access complete access right below.

Everything is open, so you have access to this cooktop and then swivel over to his sink.

And save some energy. Now I have been dying to see this. Can you show me this?

Yes, so this is one of the hidden features.

This is one of the upper cabinets. We have a fully manual pull down shelf. You can see the way it functions. It'll pull right down to a comfortable level for Sean to access anything he's looking for and then pull down and it'll gradually set itself back up.

Fantastic. This is the best idea, and it's not a permanent fixture, is it?

Not at all. So this can be transported and brought to a new location. We actually just installed them into the pretty much standard sized cabinets.

Right, so if Sean were ever to move, he could take it with them,

Exactly, comes along with him.

I love this. I absolutely love those.

Pull down shelves make a lot of sense, whether you're in a wheelchair or maybe a little height challenged like I am.

This particular unit is removable, so when the owner wishes to leave and move to a new residence, this can come with him.

Now this is also a very special feature,

So your regular wall oven will typically have a pull down door.

This one actually has a side door where it opens up so Sean again can roll up, have access to whatever meal he's prepping for that day. He has access to a drawer here and now he can transfer his his dish.

This style of oven door makes so much sense for everybody. It doesn't matter who they are, what age you are. The idea of reaching over this hot door, it doesn't make sense for anybody. So there are chef's ovens that open in the middle and come out this way.

But you can also have an opening from the left or the right. So this is what the OT and you chose to install here. Now this is another piece that is so smart. Tell me about it.

Yeah. So this was one of the priorities for Sean. He goes, Pat, you know what?

I love to entertain. Somewhere he can actually sit down with his friends and enjoy a meal. Depending on their situation, if they're sitting on a chair or was in a wheelchair so now he's got the ability of self-adjusting, fully electric countertop.

Pat Acquisto

He uses this when he does his meal preps as well so it's a multi functioning task table.

Karen Brown

So smart, so smart. If he puts it all the way down, he has the leverage he needs to cut vegetables.

Pat Acquisto

For sure.

Karen Brown

He can bring it up. He could actually bring it underneath the oven and serve right from the oven with those hot dishes. Oh, we should mention this as well. Now this is here so that Sean can do what?

Yes. So this is one of Sean's techniques that he actually improvised. What with in a wheelchair,

he had an issue with accessing his hood fan and certain electrical bylaws doesn't allow us to drop it as low as he would like, so he came up with the solution where he can now access all of his buttons from here, turn on his fan. All right.

Perfect. As well as reaching things in the upper levels. Not of that cabinet, because that's the pull down.

00;10;25;01 - 00;10;25;14 Pat Acquisto Exactly.

00;10;25;14 - 00;10;26;17 Karen Brown But the other ones as well.

00;10;26;17 - 00;10;27;26 Pat Acquisto Yes, exactly.

These kind of multipurpose pieces in a small space are the bomb.

So now we know how Sean cooks the groceries. He's figured out a special way to get the groceries, and he's going to tell us about that.

00;10;53;10 - 00;10;55;04 Karen Brown ... for getting around. Tell us about it.

OK. I did some massive research trying to find out what I can do without buying a scooter. So this right here, I call it my Handillac.

Yup, cause prior to my accident I had Cadillacs before. So now I'm handicapped.

I call it my Handillac. OK, OK, but this right here I helped design. The front was already built, but this wasn't. The attachment.

Yeah, it is a T-bar. You had to attach to your wheelchair, but I'm like, yeah, I don't want a huge metal T-bar. Took us about two months to come up with the idea.

so you can clamp down and adjust it to every wheelchair.

Now, tell me why you needed this to begin with.

OK, because I remember the place I was at. There was Tim Hortons, right right there. These are the same, but every time I wanted Tim Hortons, I'd have to call a cab.

By the time the cab comes it's hours later, plus the amount of money that it costs me to get the cab over here, it was like 60 bucks a place to get to do yet to get to a place I could see.

So I was paying pretty much a round trip ticket to Cuba. You know, just for a coffee, you know? So I said, there's got to be a better way. I just want to hook up to something and go anytime I want to.

00;12;07;15 - 00;12;18;12 Sean Kelley You got it. So what I'll do is I'll get myself in the middle ...

Sean Kelley

And I'm attached. And what I do is this is my safety valve, my safety switch, so I moved that up. Now look, my casters are off the ground.

I'll push forward. OK, then I'll take this up ... now. OK, that gets tucked away. Reverse, reverse and press forward. That's it. The maximum speed on it was 20 K, but that's far too fast for someone in a wheelchair.

So I'm happy with five K, right? A full battery will last me 50 miles.

Now tell me how it does in the snow because Canadian winters.

OK. Yes, it goes well over the snow, too.

Sean Kelley

Yeah. These casters on the ground get caught in the snow and can't do nothing.

If you just use the main wheel and these wheels here, depending on the snow you have to go through, should be OK. So loosen that up. That's normal for like normal, the road out today. But when it snows I'll bring it closer, OK, to add more weight to it.

So yes, you have your arms out here, like again you're driving a Harley.

Or a Kawasaki!

Yeah, you'd have to be closer like that. I can go out, get my coffee. I just go any time I want to.

Now, how can other people get one of these

Well, they can get a hold of me.

You've got a side gig going on.

I've got a side gig. A big side gig. I've had this for about six months now ...

... and I've been using it, using it every day, and it's mint. It is fantastic.

Sean, to me it looks like you figured out a way to gain a bit more of your independence and save money at the same time.

And not a little bit of my independence. A lot back, a lot back.

Well, thank you very much for showing that to us.

We'll make sure that people know how to get in touch with you.

Join me in the engine.

Yes.

Thank you so much for letting us look around your place. It is set up so perfectly for you.

Yeah, it is.

Tell me what it means to your independence.

Whew. It means a lot to me. I cook for myself. I shop for myself. Go whenever I want to go and I don't have to rely on someone else's schedule. I can actually go and get it myself and the freedom with my Handillac there.

I mean, I just love it. I love it because everything is more accessible for me now.

You're building quite a life for yourself.

I am now. Now I can actually do things like a normal human being. I just have to do things a different way. That's all.
